



TCA Enrollment & Tuition Agreement

I/We agree to the following:

1. To abide by the policies and procedures as described in The Classical Academy Handbook and its founding documents. I/We understand that a violation or disregard of these policies may result in the dismissal of the student from TCA.
2. I/We hereby, jointly and severally, unconditionally agree to pay TCA the tuition as outlined in accordance with the tuition policy as set forth by The Classical Academy of Sarasota and as specified below:
 - a. I/We understand that by enrolling our student/s in TCA we agree to pay the full tuition for the entire academic year in which the student is enrolled (payment options are available through FACTS).
 - b. I/We acknowledge that by registering for FACTS , we are obligated to pay tuition for the entire year as outlined by TCA Tuition Policy.
 - c. I/We understand that we have the right to purchase Tuition Insurance from FACTS. If the tuition insurance is declined, the undersigned is solely responsible for the full payment of tuition.
 - d. Cancellation of Enrollment: I/We understand that in reliance on this agreement, TCA will incur financial obligations including, but not limited to; the employment of teachers, the payment of leases, the purchase of literature and materials, etc., pursuant to the education of the enrolled student. I/We acknowledge this commitment on the part of TCA, and further acknowledge that tuition payments cannot be canceled or reduced. I/We understand I am not entitled to a refund.
 - e. Dismissal: If a student should be dismissed from TCA, due to a violation of policies or for any other reason, the entire year's tuition in which the student was enrolled, is still required to be paid.
 - f. Refund of Tuition: Tuition will not be refunded nor payment obligations reduced due to the financial commitments which TCA will incur due to the enrollment of each student.
 - g. This agreement is enforceable in a court of law.
3. I/We grant permission for the student to participate in all TCA activities, athletics and events, except as otherwise specified in writing.
4. I/We acknowledge the advantages of attending field trips and agree that TCA, its employees and the drivers and/or owners of any vehicles used for any and all field trips shall be released and exempt from any liability for all damages, including but not limited to, bodily injury or property damage, which may occur during, or in transit to or from, all field trips. Individual field trip permission slips will be sent home prior to any event requiring the transportation of students. All drivers will be required to meet minimum insurance requirements and possess a clean driving record.
