*Tuition and fee for each subsequent year will be determined by the Governing Board by January.

*Tuition includes all fees such as: curriculum, school supplies, and local field trips.

It is the heart of the TCA Governing Board to keep tuition and fees as affordable as possible while still maintaining financial responsibility. Our hope is that no family will avoid enrollment due to our tuition and related costs. TCA founders are working tirelessly to find financial assistance and scholarships for families who desire a classical education and have a true financial need. Please see tuition assistance below.

Tuition Policy for TCA 2024-2025

Application and Re-enrollment for Returning Families:

- Re-enrollment opens in January.
- \$500 per student with a \$500 deposit per student
- Returning families must re-enroll by February 16th, 2024, at 4pm.
- Enrollment & deposit fee due at the time of re-enrollment and is non-refundable.

Application and Enrollment for New Families:

- Enrollment opens in mid-February of 2024
- Applications will be reviewed in the order received.
- \$500 per student with a \$500 deposit per student
- Administration will review each application upon submittal.
- The enrollment & deposit fee is due at the time of acceptance and is non-refundable.
- Last day to submit an application for the 24/25 school year is March 8th, 2024.
- Application for the 25/26 school year will be open in October of 2024

Wait-List:

- Applications will be accepted without enrollment fee due until spot becomes available.
- Families who do not submit the enrollment fee within 48 hours of an opening will forfeit their place on the wait-list, and the next family on the wait list will be contacted.

Scholarship Applicants:

- Scholarships accepted - Step Up / AAA / FES / Hope / FES-UA *Service Plan, IEP or 504 may be required.
- New families must submit the enrollment fee which is due at the time student is enrolled.
- Any portion of tuition or fees not covered by scholarship may be paid through FACTS Management or by check to the school.

Family Empowerment Scholarship - Unique Abilities:

- TCA can accept students who receive FES-UA scholarship (formerly Gardiner and McKay scholarships)
- TCA will only accept students whose educational needs can be met by the school.
- Students and parents who are eligible to receive the FES-UA Scholarship will be required to provide a copy of the student's service plan at time of application and will meet with an administrator to determine acceptance when space is available.

Tuition Assistance:

It is recommended that families with financial need apply for the Step-Up for Students scholarship or the AAA Scholarship.

Step-Up for Students/Family Empowerment Scholarship (FES)/AAA Scholarship Fund

Step up for Students, FES, and the AAA Scholarship Fund are school choice organizations awarding private school scholarships to qualifying households in the state of Florida.
